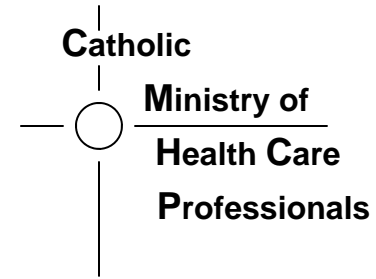

Dr. Sulmasy, a Franciscan Friar, holds the Sisters of Charity Chair in Ethics at St. Vincent's Hospital in Manhattan and serves as Professor of Medicine and Director of the Bioethics Institute of New York Medical College. He is the author of several books and articles, including "The Rebirth of the Clinic: An Introduction to Spirituality in Health Care," "The Healer's Calling: A Spirituality for Physicians and Other Health Care Professionals," and "A Balm for Gilead: Meditations on Spirituality and the Healing Arts."
